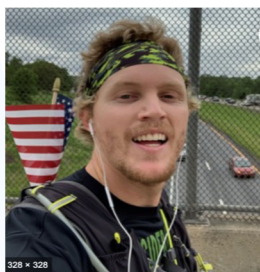

Brady Silverwood is a 24 years old from San Diego. He graduated from Torrey Pines High School and went on to study business and graduate with a marketing degree at the University of Arizona in 2017. At the age of 20 he started his first company called Sunny Co Clothing and after two very successful years he sold it in December of 2018. He was never a runner or much of an athlete growing up but joined a running club in Los Angeles in 2018. He could barely run 3 miles at the first meeting. Fast forward to March of 2019 he would run across America to show himself and others that anything is possible. On May 5th, he began a 3,311 mile run across the country. He raised over \$40,000 for numerous charities like Make-A-Wish, St. Jude, Wounded Warrior Project, National Alliance on Mental Illness.

Abolish Human Trafficking



Human Trafficking Awareness

Human trafficking is a serious issue facing the San Diego region. Thousands of victims live around us, facing the daily exploitation of buyers and traffickers. When research (done by PLNU and USD) found that recruitment of our kids was happening in our local schools the Center for Justice & Reconciliation at PLNU was asked to develop a prevention curriculum. kNOw MORE! is a peer-to-peer, drama-based curriculum that teaches students the red flags and recruitment tactics that can lead to trafficking. Seen by more than 8000 people across our region, kNOw MORE! is a powerful tool in our efforts to create a barrier between traffickers and our kids. Kim will discuss the reality of trafficking in the San Diego region, how it happens and what we can do to stop it.
