They're just friends and neighbors in San Diego, Antelope Valley, and around the globe who have a little more to share. They collect money, clothes, bedding, etc. all month and then distribute on the first Saturday of each month. They put together "Care Packs" with snacks, drinks, and toiletry items. They start the day by sorting clothes and building care packages in the parking lot on A Street. Bags were filled with toothbrushes, toothpaste, chapstick, socks, combs, hand sanitizer, aspirin, band aids, and many other everyday essentials
