The Rancho Santa Fe Rotary Club was excited and privileged to serve at <u>GenerateHope</u> on June 19th, 2021. The club armed with large and small garden tools attacked and replanted vegetable, herb, and succulent gardens for the residents that were BEYOND thankful for all the work that was done. The recovery home is for survivors of sex trafficking in San Diego.

HUGE thanks to the two dozen <u>Rotary District 5340</u> members, family, and friends that came out to <u>GenerateHope</u> to perform some much-needed facility repairs and landscaping. There also was great representation from <u>Coronado Rotary Club</u>, <u>San Diego Rotary Club</u>, <u>Rotary Club of Chula Vista-Eastlake</u>, and <u>Rotary Club of Southeast San Diego!</u> Rotary made a big difference today in the lives of several human trafficking survivors!

The clubs not only transformed their garden area but, painted the outside of the home, organized and cleaned the attic, installed a new patio umbrella for the summer, and beautified the property!

Planter 1 (Against schoolhouse wall): Pollinator Plants. This will add drought-resistant colorful plants to our yard and will attract monarch butterflies to the garden. Suggested plants: Lavender, Milkweed, and African Blue Basil

Planter 2 (Middle planter): Succulent Garden. Move Succulents that are already planted into this planter.

Planter 3 (L-shaped planter): Herb Garden (Culinary Herbs). Keep rosemary. Suggested herbs: Oregano, Bay Leaves, Thyme, Savory, Lemon Verbena, Lemon Balm. Suggested garden plants: Tomato, kale, Swiss Chard, zucchini, cucumbers, bush beans, and marigolds.
