Cinco de May, which isn't widely celebrated in Mexico, commemorates an underdog victory of the Mexican Army's victory over the French Empire at the Battle of Puebla on May 5, 1862.

In the early 1960s, many Mexican-American activists entrenched in the country's growing civil right movement used the day as a source of pride. Close to two decades later, in 1989, an ad campaign by an importer of beers like Modelo and Corona was introduced around the day. The campaign was initially targeted toward Latinos but eventually broadened with print and TV ads.

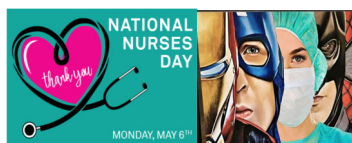
Considering that teachers mold future generations, taking one day every year to say "thank you" is the least we can do. One Child, and One Teacher can change the World.

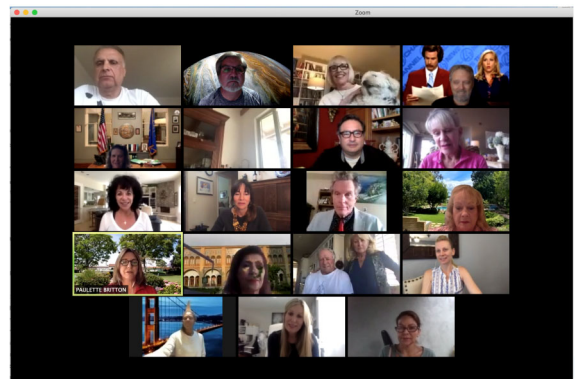
